We are deeply saddened to say farewell to Wallace Watanabe, our former president and CEO, who passed away in early September.

Wallace, who served Aloha Pacific FCU and its members for more than 40 years, was an inspiration to those of us who were fortunate to have worked with him. He was a friend and mentor, always happy to share a smile with members and employees alike.

Wallace joined the credit union in 1972 as a loan officer and rose to become president and CEO in 1992, retiring in April 2013. Under his leadership, APFCU experienced record growth and expanded its branches, including reaching out to Las Vegas.

He was a guiding light in Hawaii's credit union community as one of the founders of the shared branching system and his willingness to assist smaller credit unions with technical and financial services. He created CUSO of Hawaii Services to help credit unions process and service mortgage loans.

He truly embodied the credit union movement's mission of "people helping people."

Our mahalo to Wallace for his dedication, foresight and leadership and for making Aloha Pacific FCU the success it is today.
