



RAISING FUNDS FOR OUR COMMUNITY IN NEED

Aloha Pacific FCU and Kekaha CU are once again raising funds for Hawaii Foodbank as part of a coalition of credit unions. The campaign began June 1 and continues through July.

The need in our island community is urgent, amplified by ongoing pandemic conditions:

- Food insecurity has grown by 50 percent, as nearly a quarter of a million Hawaii residents are struggling with hunger. This includes out-of-work parents, senior citizens and one in four children.
- Since the start of the COVID pandemic, the foodbank has purchased more than \$13.2 million worth of

emergency food. The usual pre-pandemic annual budget was \$400,000.

- During 11 mass distributions, food was given to more than 40,000 households.

We're aiming to raise at least \$2,000, and will add another \$2,000 to the final total. You can help. Please donate through alohapacific.com/hawaii-foodbank or kekahacu.com/hawaii-foodbank.

Our branches also will gladly accept non-perishable food donations. The most needed items include:

- Canned proteins such as tuna, chicken and other lean meats
- Canned meals such as soup, stew, chili and pasta



- Canned vegetables
- Fruit in cans, jars or cups
- Bags of rice, especially in 2- or 5-pound packages

SURCHARGE-FREE ATM NETWORK UPDATE

Members: Please be aware of recent changes to our surcharge-free network of ATMs:

- Hawaii National Bank ATMs are no longer part of the network.
- HomeStreet Bank ATMs and University of Hawaii FCU's ATM are now part of the network.

First Hawaiian Bank, American Savings Bank and CO-OP ATMs continue to be part of the surcharge-free network; and, as always, members have free, unlimited access to all Aloha Pacific FCU ATMs.

Please keep in mind that after five non-APFCU ATM transactions per month, there is a \$2 fee per transaction.

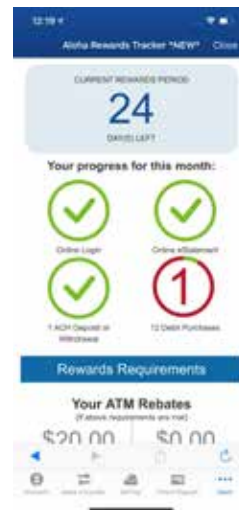

Aloha Pacific PREMIER REALTY THE HOUSING MARKET CONTINUES TO SIZZLE

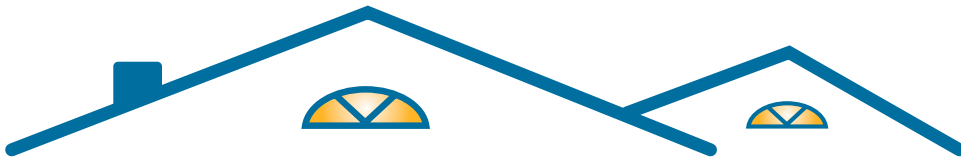
The lack of housing inventory and low interest rates are continuing to push the real estate market to new highs. The median single-family home price hit a new record of \$950,000 in March!
