Aloha Pacific FCU's Fundraising for Kauai Independent Food Bank Totals \$11,300

HONOLULU – Aloha Pacific Federal Credit Union raised more than \$11,300 in donations and matching funds for the Kaua'i Independent Food Bank to help those in need after April's devastating flooding on the Garden Isle.

Monetary donations were collected at Aloha Pacific FCU and Hawaii National Guard CU branches and online at kauaifoodbank.org in the fundraising drive that ended May 31. APFCU matched 100 percent of the donations, for a combined total of \$11,306.36.

"Mahalo to all the members, staff and general public who donated," said Vince J. Otsuka, president and CEO of APFCU. "Recovery efforts are continuing on Kauai, and we hope others will share their aloha by donating online to the food bank."
