MORE FUN AND PRIZES AT MEMBER APPRECIATION DAY

Fun Passes are now available for our 11th annual Member Appreciation Day, Saturday June 2 at the 50th State Fair!

Fun Passes, used for entry to the fair, games, rides and food, will be available for purchase at any Aloha Pacific FCU or Hawaii National Guard CU branch on Oahu.



■ **Cost:** Each primary APFCU or HNGCU member can purchase one Fun Pass for \$23. Primary members and joint account owners may also buy unlimited joint account owner/non-member Fun Passes at \$26 each.

Each Fun Pass will be pre-loaded with 325 credits, a \$32.50 value.

■ **The fair opens at 4 p.m. June 2:** Take your Fun Pass to the entrance to the fairgrounds and scan it on the admission scanner to have 30 credits deducted for admission. Once you've entered, you are free to use the credits on your Fun Pass at the rides, games, food concessions and certain attractions.

PROTECT YOURSELF FROM SCAMS

Data breaches, data mining, phishing, phone scams ... can we ever be safe?

To avoid becoming a victim of criminals, here are just a few reminders:

- Never reveal your account information or other personal details in response to an email or on the phone to someone you don't know. Legitimate financial institutions such as Aloha Pacific FCU will never ask for your information.
- Never click on a link that's included in a suspicious email. These links could

lead you to fake websites or infect your computer with malicious software.

- Create complicated online passwords that thieves won't be able to guess.
