BEWARE OF REMOTE CHECK DEPOSIT SCAM

embers: Please be aware of a scam that has surfaced using the remote check deposit function on the mobile app.



The scammer persuades the victim to give him the log-in information to the app, then remotely deposits a fraudulent check. The victim, thinking he or she has received money through remote deposit, then sends the scammer money through a wire transfer or other means. The scammer takes the money before the financial institution can determine if the deposited check is fraudulent.

You can avoid becoming a victim

of scammers:

- Never give strangers your account or log-in information.
- Hang up the phone if you receive a suspicious call pressuring you to take immediate action.
- Delete stray emails do NOT click on any link in the email.
- If an offer sounds too good to be true, it probably is.

Aloha Pacific FCU and its divisions are always working to keep your money safe and secure. Help us by being skeptical of unlikely or random offers and scammers' pressure tactics.

Bank of Nevada ATMs are no longer part of our surcharge-free network. We apologize for the inconvenience this might cause.
