Hurry! The deadline is Monday, April 22, to apply for the Masami Oishi Memorial Scholarships. Selected students will each receive \$2,000 cash scholarships this summer.

Go to the websites to download and fill in the application. Official transcripts, a letter of intent and a resume in addition to the application must be postmarked or delivered to a branch by April 22.

Important: Please note that the transcripts must be official, not photocopied or downloaded by applicants. These usually are generated by registrars offices and sealed, often featuring a raised stamp of the school or other security elements. Unofficial transcripts will disqualify your application.

Some restrictions apply. See scholarship application for details. Scholarship awards are restricted to one award per member per lifetime so that we may assist as many members as possible.
