Member Appreciation Day is happening June 1 at the 50th State Fair! This will be our 12th year of games, prizes and giveaways at Aloha Stadium.

Discount E.K. Fernandez Fun Passes, used for entry to the fair, games, rides and food, are now available for purchase at any Aloha Pacific FCU, Hawaii National Guard CU or OTS Employees CU branch on Oahu.

Cost: Each primary member of APFCU or its divisions can purchase one Fun Pass for \$23. Primary members and joint account owners may also buy unlimited joint account owner/ non-member Fun Passes at \$26 each.

Each Fun Pass will be pre-loaded with 325 credits, a \$32.50 value.

The fair opens at 4 p.m. June 1: Take your Fun Pass to the entrance to the fairgrounds and scan it on the admission scanner to have 30 credits deducted for admission. Once you've entered, you are free to use the credits on your Fun Pass at the rides, games, food concessions and certain attractions. Please note: If you arrive after 6 p.m., admission will cost you 50 credits.

Come to the main tent from 5 p.m. for our program of fun and prize giveaways – you must be present to win! Then enjoy the rest of the fair till closing.



Fun Passes are the size of a credit card and can be reloaded at kiosks at the fair. They do not expire, and can be used at other E.K. Fernandez events that accept them.

Fill out the order form and bring it to any APFCU, HNGCU or OTSECU branch on Oahu to purchase your Fun Passes. Sorry, orders by mail are not available.

Tricia graduated from Maryknoll High School and the University of Hawaii with a degree in English literature. While working on her degree, she studied as a transfer student in France and China.


It's meeting people from all walks of
