May 2021 was a record-setting month for Oahu's real estate market.

According to the Honolulu Board of Realtors, the median sales price for single-family homes reached an all-time high of \$978,000. The amount of time single-family homes and

condos were on the market before selling also hit record lows of eight and 12 days, respectively.

Those numbers, coupled with the staggering increase of homes and condos sold, show the housing market is not slowing down any time soon.

Condo sales increased 135.4% when compared to May 2020, while single-family homes rose 63.3%.
